ACCEPTED RECYCLE RALLY MATERIALS

ELIGIBLE MATERIALS

Non-Alcoholic beverage containers that fall into the following three categories are eligible for rewards through Recycle Rally.



1. ALUMINUM:

Aluminum cans of all shapes and sizes are considered eligible:

- Tabs may be left on the cans
- Aluminum cans do not need to be crushed, unless otherwise specified by your local recycling service provider or recycling center

2. PLASTIC (PET or PETE):

Most, but not all beverage containers are made of #1 PET/PETE.

Examples of types of eligible materials that are commonly made of #1 PET/PETE:



- Juice bottles
- Soda bottles
- Sports Drink bottles
- Ready-to-Drink Tea bottles



3. PLASTIC (HDPE):

HDPE plastics are usually translucent or opaque and can be mistaken for other types of plastics. Be sure to check the bottom of the container and verify that it has a #2 on it.

Examples of types of eligible materials that are commonly made of #2 HPDE:

- Milk jugs
- · Small milk and juice containers



- Please follow guidelines as specified by your local recycling service provider.
- Containers must be contaminant-free for sanitary and safety reasons.
- While it is not expected that every container will be shaken completely dry, please empty beverage containers as best as you can before recycling.

OTHER MATERIALS

Other materials will not earn reward points, but you may still log them into your account for tracking purposes. You should always check your local recycling service provider's list of accepted recyclables to ensure you are following local recycling guidelines.



OTHER PLASTICS:

#1 PET (non-beverage), #2, HDPE (non-beverage), #3 PVC, #4 LDPE, #5 PP, #6 PS, #7 Other, and unmarked.

Some examples of other plastics (i.e. those that are not eligible for credit within Recycle Rally) are:

- Yogurt containers
- Detergent bottles

- Personal care bottles (like shampoo bottles)
- Fruit containers (clamshells)



FIBER - PAPER, CARDBOARD, CORRUGATE, AND CARTON STOCK:

Examples of fiber include:

- Cardboard boxes
- Cartons
- Newsprint
- Copy paper

- Notebook paper
- Construction paper
- Poster boards
- Cardstock



GLASS:

Examples of glass include:

- Glass containers
- Glass bottles
- Glass jars

- Drinking cups
- Other glass items



OTHER METALS:

Examples of other metals include:

- Tin cans
- Steel cans

- Hardware
- Scrap metal

NOTE: While Recycle Rally only awards reward points for the eligible materials reported in your online account, we also encourage you to report and track your recycling of these other materials. By tracking your recycling totals from month-to-month or year-to-year, you can more effectively determine which new tactics are working to increase recycling and can better educate your students and staff about the opportunities and progress.
