

GUESSING GAME: HOW MANY BOTTLE CAPS?

Bottle caps can be repurposed in so many ways! Along with art projects, games are another fun way to give your caps a second life. We've provided some basic instructions for just one of the many interactive and fun games that you can play with bottle caps in the classroom.

What You'll Need:

- 1 liter or larger clear plastic container
- 150-200 bottle caps



What to Do:

- 1. Count out and record the number of bottle caps that you'll want to use for the game a number between 100-200 is usually a good amount!
- 2. Fill the container with the caps you have collected.
- 3. Pass the container around to the students. On a slip of paper, have them write down how many caps they think are in the container.
- 4. Once they've all written down their guesses, go around the classroom and collect students' answers.
- 5. Review the guesses out loud and name the winner!
- 6. For some extra encouragement, offer a prize to the student whose guess comes closest to the actual number of caps, such as giving the student an extra bonus punch on their recycling punch cards.
